Miracles of Elijah and Elisha

Elijah

- 1. Fed by food brought from Ravens (1 Kings 17:5-6)
- 2. Widow's food multiplied (1 Kings 17:12-16)
- 3. Widow's son raised to life (1 Kings 17:17-24)
- 4. Altar and sacrifice consumed in contrast to prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:16-46)
- 5. Ahaziah's soldiers consumed by fire (2 Kings 1:9-14)
- 6. Jordan River parted (2 Kings 2:6-8)
- 7. Transported to heaven (2 Kings 2:11-12)

Elisha

- 1. Jordan River parted (2 Kings 2:13-14)
- 2. Spring purified at Jericho (2 Kings 2:19-22)
- 3. Widow's oil multiplied (2 Kings 4:1-7)
- 4. Dead boy raised to life (2 Kings 4:18-37)
- 5. Poison in stew purified (2 Kings 4:38-41)
- 6. Food of prophets multiplied (2 Kings 4:42-44)
- 7. Naaman the leper healed (2 Kings 5:1-14)
- 8. Elisha's servant Gehazi becomes a leper (2 Kings 5:15-27)
- 9. Ax head (of iron) floats (2 Kings 6:1-7)
- 10. Aramean army blinded (2 Kings 6:8-23)

Note:

Contrast Yahweh with Baal. Baal was the fertility and agricultural god of the Canaanites. The miracles authenticate the message of the prophets and demonstrate Yahweh's power and sovereignty.
